Eligibility	Children under the age of 18 (as of April 1, 2018) whether inside or outside of Japan
Entry period	Friday, July 20 to Friday, November 30, 2018
Theme	My Dream
Screening	<p>First screening Screening of electronic data Main screening Screening of drawings in person</p> <p>① <u>If you pass the first screening (around January 2019), we will ask you to send your drawing paper to the office. Please keep it in a safe place. (For the main screening, judges will evaluate the actual drawings.)</u></p> <p>② The results of the first screening will be announced around February 2019.</p> <p>③ We do not respond to inquiries regarding the screening.</p>
Prizes	<p>Gold Prize: One drawing, Silver Prize: One drawing, Bronze Prize: One drawing, Honorable Mentions: Ten drawings</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The prizewinners will be announced during the anniversary ceremony for the center's 30th anniversary on May 5, 2019. (Winners will be notified in advance.) The winners of the Gold Prize and Silver Prize (children and a parent) will be invited to the monument unveiling ceremony (after fall 2019).
About the entries	<p>① The entries will not be returned.</p> <p>② The copyright to the entries belongs to the sponsor. The entries will be used for the purpose of display, PR materials, and other displays.</p> <p>③ The personal information of the entrants will not be used for any other purposes outside of the competition.</p>

How to enter

1 Please draw on an A4-sized or B4-sized sheet of drawing paper. (Octavo drawing paper (270 mm x 380 mm) is also accepted.)

Drawings can be either vertical or horizontal.
They must be drawn by the children themselves on a flat surface and must not have been previously published.

2 Take a photo of the drawing. (Scanned drawings are also accepted.)
